This program for english speaking students is available in collaboration with Rudolf Steiner College in Fair Oaks-Sacramento, California. There are two options: 3 or 4 years. For the french speaking students who would like to choose this program it is necessary to prove one's fluency in english. Irene Francois will be responsible for that.

4-Year Program:

2 intensives weeks in Montréal: October 9-14/ 2008 and March 1-5/ 2009
3 intensives weeks in July at Rudolf Steiner College, Fair Oaks-Sacramento, California
1 Research project
1 week practicum on a biodynamic farm
2 week observation in a Waldorf School

The cost for this program is: IRSQ: CDN \$ 2 000 per year (not included the registration fees of \$250, the 1st year only)

RSC: US \$ 3 190 per year (included the registration fees of \$190)*

3 Year Program:

2 intensive weeks in Montréal: 1. October 9-14/ 2008
2. March 1-5/ 2008
3 intensives weeks in July 2008 in Fair Oaks, Sacramento, California (dates TBA)
2 series of 8 weekends in Montreal: 1.Oct.18-Dec.13/2008
2. March 14-May10 /2009
1 Research project
1 week practicum on a biodynamic farm
2 week observation in a Waldorf School

The cost for this program is: IRSQ: CDN \$ 3 500 per year (not included the registration fees of \$250 the 1st year only)

RSC: US \$ 3 190 per year (included the registration fees of \$190)*

A contract is signed with both institutes. Diplomas will be delivered by both institutes. All students registered with IRSQ and RSC Programs are eligible for financial aid.

*This is the actual rate at RSC; it might be increasing up to 3% in 2009.
